Dispensary Licenses



- Certificate of Operation
 - Awarded Dec. 12 to CY+
 - 180 Main Street, Wintersville
- Continuing to schedule and conduct inspections
- Continued communications



Patient & Caregiver Registry

- Activated Monday, December 3, 2018
- After one week:
 - 1,948 recommendations in the Registry
 - 1,062 have activated their Registry Card
 - 23 caregivers with activated cards

Frequently-Asked Questions

 - Check junk and spam folders
 - Contact MMCP at 1-833-464-6627 or email at MMCPRegistry@pharmacy.ohio.gov with first name, last name, date of birth and preferred email address
 - New registration link can be sent
- If I am applying as a patient with veteran or indigent status, how will my fee reduction be applied?
 - Do not submit payment for registration fee until patient status is approved
 - Refunds not issued for registration fees paid before special status approval

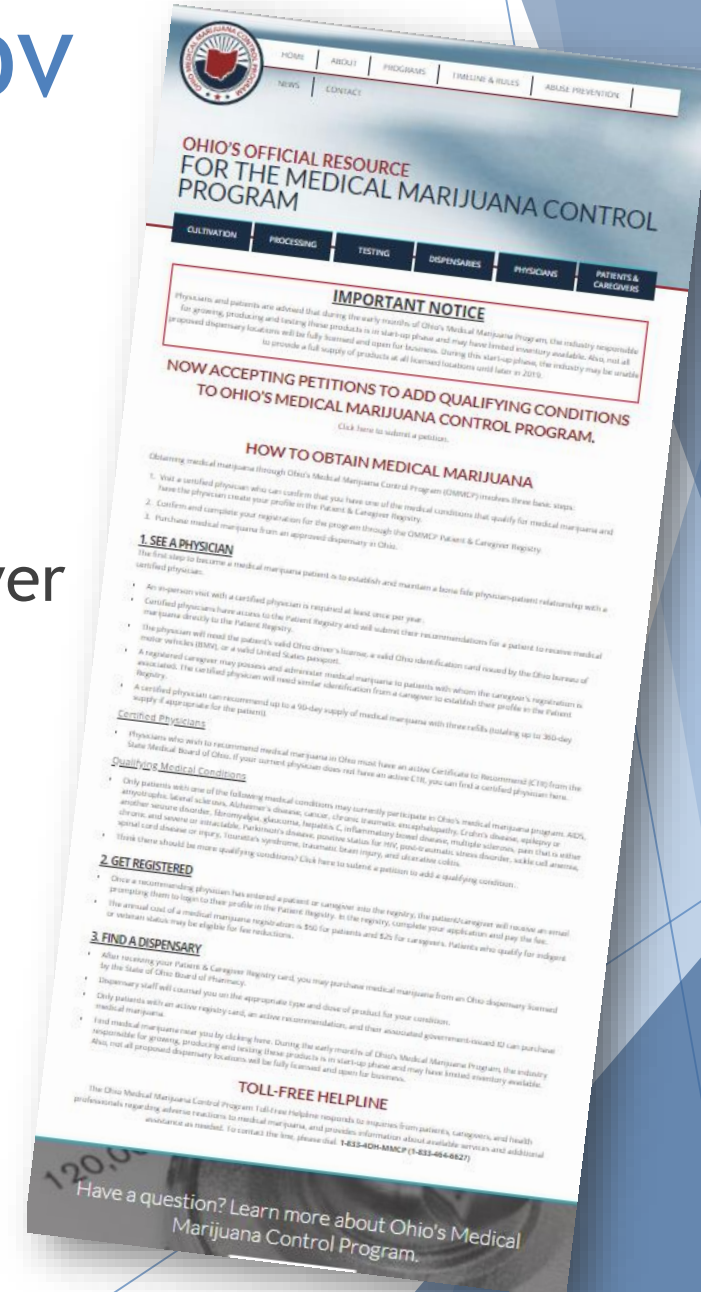
Form and Method of Administration Petition - Nasal Spray

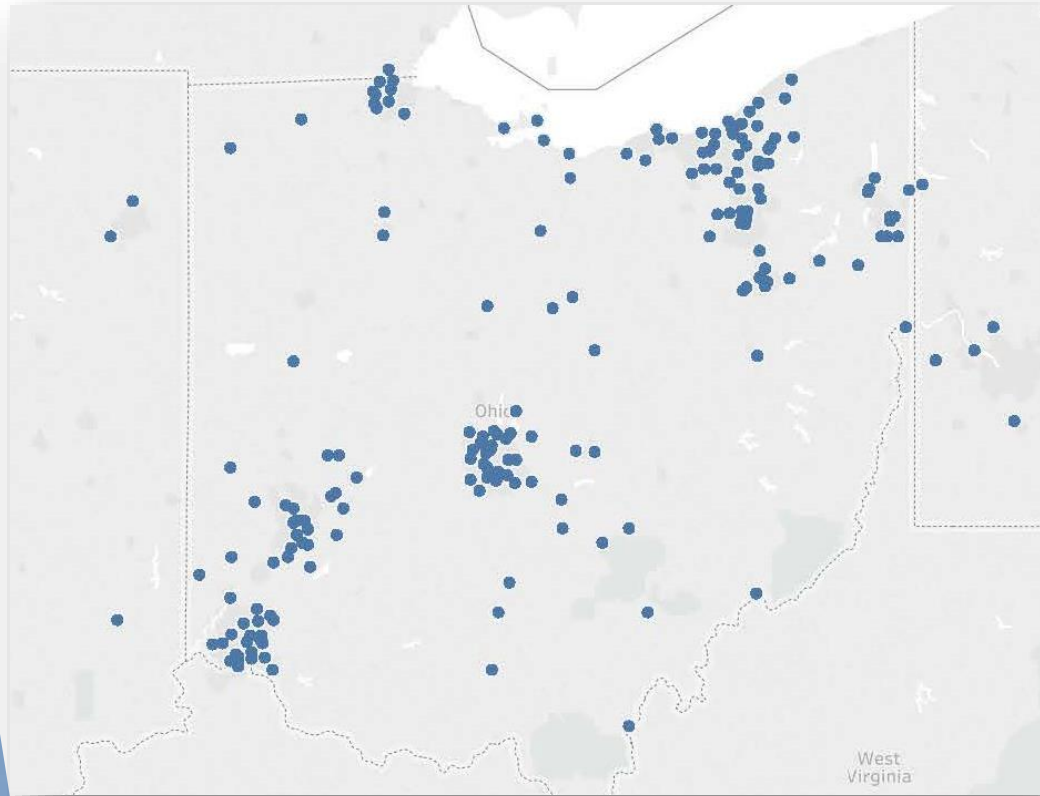
December 2018 Update

Petition to Add Conditions

- 70 petitions received; all will be thoroughly reviewed
- Petition window open Nov. 1 - Dec. 31, 2018
- Submissions via webform on MedicalMarijuana.ohio.gov
- Petitions require (per 4731-32-05 OAC):
 - Information from experts who specialize in condition
 - Relevant medical, scientific evidence
 - Are conventional medical therapies insufficient?
 - Evidence supporting use of medical marijuana to treat condition, other types of medical/scientific documentation
 - Letters of support provided by physicians

Guiding Principles

- ▶ Patient-centered and safe
- ▶ Responsive, data-driven, and transparent
- ▶ Flexible, scalable, and sustainable

Operational Status

- ▶ Cultivators
 - ▶ 14 Certificates of Operation
- ▶ Processors
 - ▶ 14 provisional licenses
 - ▶ Round 2 processor applications
- ▶ Testing Labs
 - ▶ Inspection Timeline





Economically Disadvantaged Groups

- ▶ Ohio Revised Code 3796.09 (C)
- ▶ *PharmaCann LLC v. Ohio Department of Commerce*
 - ▶ Decision 11/15/18
 - ▶ EDG requirement ruled unconstitutional
- ▶ Existing EDG cultivator licensees
- ▶ Other licensing implications



MMCP Budget

- ▶ Common fund - Commerce and Pharmacy
- ▶ Controlling Board - December 17
- ▶ Legal expenditures
 - ▶ Increased spending authority
- ▶ Revenue timing challenges
 - ▶ License fees at time of Certificate of Operation
 - ▶ Delays in certificates = delays in revenue
 - ▶ Cash transfer (loan) from emergency purposes fund
