# Dispensary Application Clarification

- Dispensary rules allow for the Board to notify Applicants of deficiencies in submitted Applications
- Applicants receiving such notice must respond within 5 calendar days after being notified of a deficiency
- Applications for which no response is received may be considered abandoned
  - Forfeited fees
  - Board not required to act on application

- Notice will be sent to the email address provided in response to Application Section A-2
- Letter detailing necessary action will also be sent certified mail
- Scanned copy of the letter will be attached to email

- Must respond to inquiries from patients, caregivers, and health professionals regarding adverse reactions to medical marijuana
