IMPORTANT UPDATES

Terpene Reporting

Dispensaries may pull terpene information from METRC, as Testing Labs now have the ability to report terpene testing results into Metrc for the following common terpenes:

- Alpha-Bisabolol
- Alpha-Humulene
- Alpha-Pinene
- Alpha-Terpinene
- Beta-Caryophyllene
- Beta-Myrcene
- Beta-Pinene
- Caryophyllene Oxide
- Limonene
- Linalool

If reporting terpene testing results in Metrc, they must be reported by the testing laboratory as either a percentage or milligrams, consistent with how cannabinoids are reported for the product type.

COMPLIANCE

Quality Assurance/Small Batch Deliveries

The MMCP guidance has been updated to note: "*and may only be sold to registered patients at fair market value of like and similar goods readily available for sale by the dispensary,*" (e.g., if the item is sold for \$23, then it must be sold to the employee/patient at the same price for small batch). Selling any product less than fair market value is prohibited.

As a reminder, dispensaries are required to notify their applicable agent if they intend to participate in selling small batch products, and provide the name of the cultivator and or processor they will be working with. This information will be verified upon inspection.

Employee Separation Notification Form

The Employee Separation Notification Form has been updated and will now require the dispensary to add the Dispensary City and Dispensary County, to include a detailed reason for separation. Please begin utilizing the new form.
