BOARD OF PHARMACY AWARDS DISPENSARY CERTIFICATES OF OPERATION IN LIMA, CAMBRIDGE, DAYTON, RAVENNA, ASHTABULA, EUCLID, KENT, MILFORD, STRUTHERS & OXFORD

The State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy awarded its 78th Dispensary Certificate of Operation to Inspire Cannabis, located at 5280 College Corner Pike, Oxford. The [interactive map](#) of Dispensaries with Certificates of Operation will be updated within two business days of April 27, 2023.

The 77th Dispensary Certificate of Operation was awarded to Green Leaf Therapy, located at 93 S Bridge St., Struthers.

The 75th Dispensary Certificate of Operation was awarded to Bliss Ohio, located at 331 E Main St., Kent.

The 73rd Dispensary Certificate of Operation was awarded to Italian Herbs, located at 2712 W Prospect Rd., Ashtabula.

LICENSING

Medical Marijuana Dispensary and Employee Renewal Information

Medical Marijuana Dispensary Certificate of Operation and Dispensary Employee (Associated Key, Key, and Support) license renewal information can be reviewed [here](#).

- Dispensary Certificate of Operation renewal applications must be submitted no later than May 17, 2023.

- Dispensary Employee renewal applications will open on May 2, 2023 and must be submitted no later than July 1, 2023.

NOTE: Only licenses with an 'Active' status and expiration date of July 1, 2023 will be eligible for renewal. Any employee who has experienced a separation of employment from a dispensary and therefore has an Inactive license, must complete a reinstatement application. Employees licensed prior to April 1, 2023, who are associated with a dispensary awarded a certificate of operation as part of RFA II, will be required to renew even though the dispensary's certificate of operation is not subject to renewal in 2023.

PATIENT SURVEY

The Drug Enforcement and Policy Center (DEPC) at The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law has traced the development of the Ohio Medical Marijuana Control Program (OMMCP) since the start of legal sales in January 2019.
