Product ID Background

- All medical marijuana products must have an assigned Product ID to be accepted by a dispensary
- Without a Product ID dispensaries cannot report the dispensation to the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program
- Processors and Cultivators will not be able to transfer product without a Product ID
- This applies to each medical marijuana strain and medical marijuana form and dose
- The assignment of a Product ID is to ensure that only products in compliance with MMCP regulations are available to patients and their caregivers

Product ID - Relevant Legal Authority



 All medical marijuana strains and products must be registered with the Ohio Department of Commerce and assigned a Product ID in METRC by the Board of Pharmacy (OAC 3796:8-2-05)

 Before any medical marijuana strain or product may be sold to a dispensary, each dose and packaged quantity of that product must be assigned a product identifier.

• The Board of Pharmacy will review submissions for Product IDs. Issuance of a product identifier serves as evidence that the registered product complies with ORC 3796.06 and OAC 3796:8.

Authorized Forms and Methods of Medical Marijuana



Form	90-Day Supply	1-Day Supply
Tier I plant material (up to 23% THC)	8 ounces of plant material; 10 ounces for terminal exception	See Reference Guide
Tier II plant material (23% - 35% THC). Higher than 35% THC is prohibited.	5.3 ounces of plant material; 6.6 ounces for terminal exception	See Reference Guide
Oils for vaporizing	53.1 grams of THC; 65.7 grams for terminal exception	590 milligrams
Patches for transdermal administration; lotions, creams, or ointments for topical administration	26.6 grams of THC; 33.3 grams for terminal exception	295 milligrams
Edibles, oils, and tinctures for oral administration	9.9 grams of THC; 11.7 grams for terminal exception	110 milligrams

Dose vs. Unit Explained



Definition of Dose

- Portion or quantity of medical marijuana intended to be consumed at a single time (e.g. – One gummy or one capsule).
- No dose of tinctures, capsules, patches, edibles or oils for oral administration may exceed 50 mg of THC.

Definition of Unit

- Total target THC or CBD in the packaged product.
- In METRC, the Unit Quantity is automatically calculated by multiplying the Supply Duration by the 1-Day Supply

Non-Plant Material Product Naming Convention Overview for an Item Brand



When creating the name of an Item Brand industry needs to use the following naming convention:

[Form and Method] – [Target THC Content(mg) per dose] – [Target CBD Content(mg) per dose]

E.G. – Oil Oral Admin – 11-0

Please note: There is a 30 character limit for this field in OARRS. All required information needs to be within those first 30 characters.

Non-Plant Material Product Naming Convention Overview for an Item



When creating the name of an Item industry needs to use the following naming convention:

[Form and Method] – [Target THC Content(mg) per dose] – [Target CBD Content(mg) per dose] - [# of doses]

E.G. – Oil Oral Admin – 11-0-10

Please note: There is a 30 character limit for this field in OARRS. All required information needs to be within those first 30 characters. The number of doses is not required for lotions and ointments.

Medical Marijuana Allowable THC Content Range for Brand Items / Items



- The allowable range of THC content for medical marijuana is defined as
 - 95% below the total target THC content per dose reported when Product ID assigned
 - 105% above the total target THC content per dose reported when Product ID assigned
- THC content is calculated by multiplying the THCA content by 0.877 and then adding the THCA content
- CBD content should be calculated in the same manner as THC content

Zero Threshold for THC and CBD Content



- The Board will establish thresholds at which Non-Plant products would be considered to have zero THC or zero CBD Content


Minimum Submission Requirements (From OAC 3796:8-2-05)




- Name of the medical marijuana entity
- Medical marijuana entity license issued by the department
- Name of product
- Product description
- The form and intended method or methods of administration
- An image of the product (only for Non-Plant Material)
- Product dose
- Days supply of the product for each product package that will be available
- Product ingredients
- Remit required fee of \$100+ \$2 service charge for each Item Brand







Example: Metered Oil or Solid for Vaporization

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



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


Example: Lotion for Topical Administration
