Caregiver Registration

On August 9, 2021, the Board of Pharmacy voted to terminate the [Temporary Expansion of Caregiver Registration](#), effective September 8, 2021. **All caregivers must now be registered through a recommending physician and the Board will no longer be able to register caregivers directly.** Additionally, each patient will be permitted to have up to two caregivers linked to their account and each caregiver will be permitted to have up to two patients.

Notwithstanding the two patient and two caregiver limit, a request for additional caregivers or additional patients over the allowed limit may be made to the Board pursuant to [OAC 3796:7-2-02\(F\)](#). Written requests for additional caregivers should be emailed to the Board at MMCPRegistry@pharmacy.ohio.gov.

RFA II Provisional Dispensary License Issued August 2022

On August 9, 2022, the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy issued a provisional dispensary license as part of the RFA II process.

The Southeast-1 district, provisional dispensary license was granted to SEO NATURAL ENTERPRISES, LLC, located at 3210 Rhodes Avenue, New Boston, OH 45662.

Registry Reminders

Registration Renewal

An Ohio Medical Marijuana Control Program Registry Card does not expire until the expiration date listed on the card. A patient may renew their registration beginning 30 days before the registration's expiration date. **Registrants do not receive an automated email from the Registry with a link to renew their registration.** Within 30 days of the registration expiration date, patients may visit www.ohiomedicalmarijuanaregistry.com and login with their registered email address and password. Once logged in, patients may select the "RENEW CARD" button listed under the registration card. Caregivers will still renew their registration within 90 days of the registration expiring. **NOTE:** If the registration and recommendation are expired, the patient will need to obtain a new recommendation before they can renew the registration. After the new recommendation is issued, the "RENEW CARD" button will appear in the Registry account, and the patient can complete the renewal process.
