Registry Reminders

Updating Demographic Information in Your Registry Profile

To change the name, ID, or date of birth associated with your Registry profile, registrants must contact their recommending physician to make the change. The recommending physician must update the registry of a patient or caregiver as they are responsible for registering the patient and verifying a patient's identity. 1. Go to www.ohiomedicalmarijuanaregistry.com and login with your registered email address and password.
2. Click the "EDIT" button on the lower right-hand side of the Demographics tab.
3. Enter your the new street address, email address or phone number.
4. Click "SAVE CHANGES".
