### BOARD OF PHARMACY AWARDS DISPENSARY CERTIFICATES OF OPERATION IN BOWLING GREEN, HARPSTER, LIMA AND CAMBRIDGE

This month, the State of Ohio Board of pharmacy awarded four certificates of operation:

- Nectar Medical Cannabis Dispensary, located in Bowling Green, Ohio
- Ohio Cannabis Company, located in Harpster, Ohio
- Backroad Wellness, located in Lima
- Backroad Wellness, located in Cambridge

The Board has now issued 70 dispensary certificates of operation.

## PATIENT SURVEY

The Drug Enforcement and Policy Center (DEPC) at The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law has traced the development of the Ohio Medical Marijuana Control Program (OMMCP) since the start of legal sales in January 2019. ## REGISTRY REMINDERS

### Updating Registry Demographics

To change the name, ID, or date of birth associated with your Registry profile, registrants must contact their recommending physician to make the change. [Rule 3796:7-2-01](#) requires the recommending physician to update the Registry profile of a patient or caregiver as they are responsible for registering the patient and verifying a patient's identity.

Patients and caregivers can edit their own address, email address, and phone number by following the below steps:

1. Go to [www.ohiomedicalmarijuanaregistry.com](http://www.ohiomedicalmarijuanaregistry.com) and login with your registered email address and password.
2. Once logged in, click the "EDIT" button on the right-hand side under your information
3. Enter your new address, phone number or email address.
4. Click "SAVE CHANGES".

### **Registration Renewal**

An Ohio Medical Marijuana Control Program Registry Card does not expire until the expiration date listed on the card. A patient may renew their registration beginning 30 days before the registration's expiration date. Registrants do not receive an automated email from the Registry with a link to renew their registration. Within 30 days of the registration expiration date, patients may visit [www.ohiomedicalmarijuanaregistry.com](http://www.ohiomedicalmarijuanaregistry.com) and login with the registered email address and password. Once logged in, patients may select the "RENEW CARD" button listed under the registration card. **Caregivers will still renew their registration within 90 days of the registration expiring.**

**NOTE:** If the registration and recommendation are expired, the patient will need to obtain a new recommendation before they can renew the registration. After the new recommendation is issued, the "RENEW CARD" button will appear in the Registry account, and the patient can complete the renewal process.
