BOARD OF PHARMACY AWARDS DISPENSARY CERTIFICATES OF OPERATION IN COLUMBUS, MONROE, AND CANTON

The State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy awarded certificates of operation to the following dispensaries:

- Trulieve Medical Marijuana Dispensary, located in Columbus
- Shangri-La Dispensary, located in Monroe
- The Green Goat Dispensary, LLC, located in Canton
- Firelands Scientific Dispensary, located in Columbus
- The Landing Dispensary, located in Columbus

The Board has now issued 96 dispensary certificates of operation.

STATE BUDGET UPDATE - MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONTROL PROGRAM

The state operating budget was signed into law on July 4 and included language to establish the Division of Marijuana Control within the Ohio Department of Commerce.

The new Division is tasked with administering the Medical Marijuana Control Program, including the licensing and regulation of medical marijuana cultivators, processors, testing laboratories, and dispensaries, and overseeing the Patient & Caregiver Registry.

The legislation requires the transition of the oversight of dispensaries and the Patient & Caregiver Registry from the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy to the Department of Commerce to be complete by December 31, 2023.

The MMCP will communicate any changes or updates as they happen. Until you are instructed otherwise, dispensaries, patients, and caregivers should continue working with the Board of Pharmacy.

The MMCP will work with all licensees to ensure a smooth transition through engagement, collaboration, and communication during this process. We will provide updates as soon as possible and appreciate your patience.

REGISTRY REMINDERS

REGISTRATION & RECOMMENDATION EXPIRATION DATES

The registration expiration date on your medical marijuana card is for your registration with the Ohio Medical Marijuana Control Program. The annual registration fee entitles a registrant to a full year of registration. Therefore the registration expiration date will always be the last day of the month, one year from when the patient or caregiver activated or renewed the registration and paid the annual fee. (e.g., if you last renewed your registration and paid the fee on 7/10/2023, your registration expiration date will be 7/31/2024).

Pursuant to rules [3796:7-2-04](#) and [3796:8-2-04](#) of the Administrative Codes, the maximum amount of time a physician can issue a recommendation for is 90-days with up to three 90-day refills – for a total of 360 days. Thus, a patient’s recommendation from their physician will expire before their patient registration.
